HISTORIC CITY TOUR COMBINED WITH ONE ATTRACTION for Plan 3A and 4A:

Take a journey through Charleston's 300 years of living history with our licensed tour guides. Experience the Old Market area and the historic homes and churches where generations of Charlestonians worked, lived, and worshiped. Fort Sumter. Fort Sumter is a sea fort built on an artificial island near Charleston, South Carolina to defend the region from a naval invasion. It was built after British forces captured and occupied Washington during the War of 1812 via a naval attack

OR Harbor Cruise. Enjoy a boat tour of Charleston Harbor narrated by licensed tour guides. See and hear about Fort Sumter, the history of the harbor & the Aircraft Carrier Yorktown at Patriots Point.

OR Charleston Museum. Located in the Wraggborough neighborhood in Charleston. It is the oldest museum in the United States. Its collection includes historic artifacts, natural history, decorative arts and two historic Charleston houses.

PLANTATION TOURS

Boone Hall Plantation. This beautiful gem is nestled in the Town of Mount Pleasant, just across the harbor from Charleston. Enter through the Avenue of Oaks and take a guided tour of the historic mansion. Enjoy a self-guided tour through the original slave cabins and learn about the African American experience presented by a licensed guide. 4 hours

Magnolia Plantation. Take a tour of the Drayton family home founded in 1676. Take in the beauty of the plantations wetland, lakes, forests, and marshes with a nature train ride. See everything from alligators and turtles to herons and egrets on this 45-minute tram ride. Includes: 45 minute guided house tour; 45 minute nature tram tour.
