## Sightseeing – City Tours

### NARRATED CITY TOUR BY HORSE-DRAWN CARRIAGE

This narrated tour travels approximately 2.5 miles as it covers 30 blocks of the historic district, where you will view landscaped gardens, antebellum mansions, churches and other treasured landmarks. Approx 1 hr.

### NARRATED CITY TOUR BY AIR-CONDITIONED MINIBUS

Take a journey through Charleston's 300 years of living history with our licensed tour guides. Experience the Old Market area and the historic homes and churches where generations of Charlestonians worked, lived and worshiped. Approx 1.5 hrs

## Sightseeing – City Tours Combined with One Attraction

**FORT SUMTER:** See and hear about Fort Sumter, the Harbor of History and the Aircraft Carrier Yorktown at Patriots Point. Includes a cruise to historic Fort Sumter "where the Civil War began." Approx 2.5 hrs.

**HARBOR CRUISE:** Enjoy a boat tour of Charleston harbor narrated by licensed tour guides. Harbor tour last 90 min. Approx 3 hrs.

**CHARLESTON MUSEUM:** America's First Museum, has been discovering, preserving, interpreting, celebrating, and sharing ever since. Approx 2 hrs.

## Sightseeing – Plantation Tours

**BOONE HALL PLANTATION:** Visit Boone Hall Plantation, one of America's oldest working plantations. This beautiful gem is nestled in the town of Mount Pleasant, across the harbor from Charleston. Enter through the Avenue of Oaks and take a guided, narrated tour of the historic mansion. Enjoy a self guided tour through the original slave cabins and learn about the African American experience. Transportation included. Approx 4 hrs.

**MAGNOLIA PLANTATION AND GARDENS:** Selected as one of "America's Most Beautiful Gardens" by Travel Leisure Magazine. Take a tour of the Drayton family home founded in 1676. Take in the beauty of the plantations wetland, lakes, forests and marshes with a Nature Train ride. See everything from alligators and turtles to herons and egrets on this 45 minute tram ride. Includes transportation. Approx 4 hrs.
