Sightseeing

HOPPER TOUR: Provides access to all important stops: L’Enfant Plaza, Air & Space Museum, Smithsonian Museum, Lincoln Memorial, Washington Monument, Jefferson Memorial, MLK and FDR Memorials, Korean and Vietnam War Memorials, Arlington National Cemetery, Natural History Museum, White House, US Capitol Building and The Wharf.

WATER TAXI: Roundtrip to Alexandria, VA. Alexandria, Virginia, is a city on the Potomac River, just south of Washington, DC. It’s known for its Old Town, with brick sidewalks and well-preserved 18th- and 19th-century buildings. King Street is lined with boutiques and specialty shops. Founding fathers dined at Gadsby’s Tavern, now a museum with period objects and photographs. See Christ Church, where George Washington and Thomas Jefferson worshipped.

ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY: Arlington National Cemetery is located on a parcel of land that once belonged to George Washington’s step-grandson, George Washington Parke Custis. In 1857, Custis left the property to his daughter Mary Anna Randolph Custis and it became the family home for her and her husband, Robert E. Lee. After the Lee family vacated the property at the onset of the Civil War in 1861, the grounds were used for various purposes, including serving as

a camp and headquarters for Federal Troops during the Civil War and later providing a safe haven for former slaves seeking freedom. Arlington National Cemetery held its first military burial on May 13, 1864. Today, the property is the final resting place for more than 400,000 active duty service members, veterans and their families. It is a place to remember the men and women who served their nation.

MONUMENTS BY MOONLIGHT: Enjoy the Monuments and Memorials from a whole different perspective...illuminated at night! Stops at: Lincoln Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall, Korean War Memorial, Franklin Delano Roosevelt Memorial OR Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial, White House (Photo Stop). View from the coach: WWII Memorial, U.S. Capitol Building, Pennsylvania Ave, Washington Monument, U.S. Capitol Reflecting Pool, Federal Triangle. 2.5 hours.

WATER CRUISE TO MT. VERNON, VA: Cruise on the Potomac River to Mount Vernon on this day trip from Washington DC. Listen to informative narration on board the boat, and then take a self-guided tour of George and Martha Washington’s estate. Admission onto grounds and the plantation home are included. Return to Washington DC later in the day.
