New Orleans Sightseeing

CITY TOUR: Tour highlights include the French Quarter, Garden District, St. Louis Cemetery #3, City Park, 9th Ward.

NATCHEZ HARBOR CRUISE WITH LUNCH: Take a two-hour cruise along the Mississippi River and experience New Orleans beauty and French Quarter romance. Enjoy jazz music and regional food, buffet style.

FRENCH QUARTER WALKING TOUR: See the Old Quarter come to life as your guide explains its secrets and helps you understand all it has to offer – architecture, courtyards, gardens, food, music, and art.

GARDEN DISTRICT/MANSION WALKING TOUR: Enjoy a walk through New Orleans' elegant Garden District, once part of the plantation owned by Bienville, the founder of New Orleans. The homes of former Kings and Queens of Mardi Gras are located here, as well as the home of the premier family of football - the Mannings - where Archie lives and Peyton and Eli grew up. Other celebrity residents are actor John Goodman, celebrated singer Aaron Neville and Toby's Corner, the oldest house in the area (built in 1838).

TWO PLANTATION TOUR: The combination choices are: Laura/Whitney, Laura/Oak Alley, or Whitney/Oak Alley. For proper planning, guests must visit the two plantations selected at time of booking this tour.

OAK ALLEY BRUNCH & SWAMP COMBO TOUR: At Oak Alley, enjoy a sumptuous Plantation Country Brunch featuring Crawfish Etouffee, Chicken & Smoked Sausage Gumbo, Oeuf du Jour (egg dish of the day), Cajun Smoked Sausage Links, and other offerings. Then it's a short ride to the Manchac Swamp where you will cruise through a privately-owned wildlife refuge, home to the legend of "Rougarou," the Cajun werewolf. You might not find the "Rougarou," but you'll get up close and personal with some alligators in an area where time seems to stand still.

PADDLE & WHEEL TOUR: Combines the City Tour and the Natchez Day Cruise (without Lunch).

OAK ALLEY PLANTATION: Marvel at the quarter-mile long alley of 29 majestic Oak trees, all 250 years old; enjoy fascinating stories of the plantation and its history.

WHITNEY PLANTATION: Enjoy the history of this sugar plantation, built in 1803; the tour pays homage to the slaves who lived and worked there.

SWAMP & BAYOU TOUR: Take a short coach ride to the Louisiana Swamplands, then board a custom-built swampboat and observe the nesting grounds of alligators, egrets, raccoons and many species of snakes and birds.
